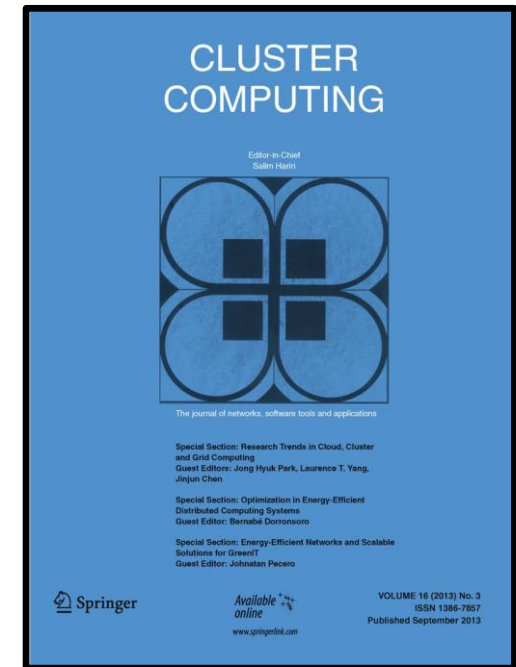
Announcements – INDIS 2020 Special Journal Issue
